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NOTICE TO CAREGIVERS ABOUT MEDICAL/DENTAL SERVICES

When a child (CMDP Member) is placed in your care by the Department of Child Safety (DCS), please:

- When you get the CMDP ID Card use it when seeing a doctor or a dentist or filling medication prescriptions. If you do not receive a card, contact member services.
- Do not pay for any medical services, dental services or prescriptions even if you are asked to! Contact CMDP if the provider has any questions.
- If you need to find a doctor or dentist you can look in the Provider Directory which is available online or you can contact CMDP Provider Services for help or if you have any questions.
- Look in the *Member Handbook* for more information which is also on the CMDP website or you can request one by calling CMDP.
- If you have concerns about the care provided to your child by a provider or facility, please contact the medical services department to talk to a Quality Management nurse.
- Be aware that children are required to see a doctor and dentist within thirty (30) days of placement. They are then to see the doctor ten (10) times by the age of 2 years and every year after. They are to see the dentist every 6 months after the age of one!
